Course Description

In this elective class, you will be learning about asians in mainstream media. More specifically, the evolution of Asian representation and how they are correctly/incorrectly portrayed in mainstream American Media. As we progress throughout the course, we should be asking ourselves questions before we start the unit, while we learn the unit, and after we finish the unit. Our learning objectives could be answered through the following questions that we should keep in mind as we learn each unit.

Unit 1: Frequency

How often do we *now* see Asian representation in mainstream media in comparison to before?

Unit 2: Accuracy

When we *do* see Asian representation in mainstream media, how are they portrayed? Just like "normal" characters? Are they stereotyped?

Unit 3: Asian Pacific Islander

How are API portrayed in mainstream media? Are they seen under Asian representation?

Unit 4: South Asian

How are South Asians portrayed in mainstream media? With Bollywood being the Hindi mainstream media, how do Hollywood and Bollywood differ?

Unit 5: Asian LGBTQ+

How are the Asian LGBTQ+ represented in mainstream media? Compare it to how LGBTQ+ are represented in mainstream media in general? Is there a difference?

Unit 6: Asian American

What is an Asian American? What culture do they associate with? Their Asian or American side?

Unit 7: Representation in Hollywood

Where do we go from here? How can representation progress? How can we help with this progression?
